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Zerah Of JUDAH

Also known as ZEUS, of Greek Mythology

It is interesting to note that the Greeks correctly believed that the Gods are men and women like us -- immortal men and women with superpowers or supernatural capabilities. The only thing the Greeks got wrong was the personalities or the dispositions of the Gods. The Greeks erroneously believed that the Gods had fallen, vicious, vengeful, vindictive, jealous, and hateful personalities like us rather than exalted and perfected personalities. You see, the Greeks didn't know what it took for mortal men and

women to become Gods because the Greeks didn't have the Gospel of Christ. But, it is interesting to see how much they did get right in their mythology.

The other thing that the Greeks got wrong is that they believed that when you kill a God, he stays dead. The Greeks didn't know anything about resurrection. The Egyptians knew that the Gods and mortal men could rise from the dead or be reborn, but the Greeks did not. The Greeks believed that once dead, you stayed dead, and only your spirit continued to live in Hades or the Underworld.
